General Appearance

- Make-up and nail polish are unsuitable for school and are not permitted.
- No facial piercings or substitute studs are permitted at any time.
- A watch may be worn and students may wear one pair of earring studs or sleepers or hoop (max 10 cent size) only. Other jewellery is not permitted.
- Hair styles must be neat and suitable for school. If girls wish to wear ribbons or headbands, they must be in the school colours of green, white, black, grey or maroon. Extreme hairstyles/hair colours are not permitted.
- Students with long hair are required to tie it back for physical education, sports activities and some technology areas.
- The wearing of a wide-brimmed sun hat, outdoors only, is encouraged between September and April
- Boys are expected to be clean shaven.
- No coloured t shirts, hooded tops or other garments should be worn with the uniform.
- Footwear – No exceptions permitted. See Uniform above.
- All items of uniform must be clearly labelled with the student's name.
